Café Culture at Scotstoun

Road Safety Reminder

Several members of our community have raised ongoing concerns about road safety around the school and being confronted by parents. As a reminder, we are a car free zone from 8.15am until 9am and again at 2.30pm to 3.15pm. This means that you cannot drive into the four streets that immediately surround the school during these times unless you have a resident's permit. You should also not:

park or stop on the keep clear zones which are clearly marked on the corners;
stop in the middle of the road to let your child out;

• park on the zig zag lines outside the school.

This should be enforced by Police Scotland only.

In the Ormiston Avenue school entrance, we have pre-loved uniform which can be accessed by families from 9am or 2.30pm each day. Lost property is also located there and it can be accessed during those times as well.
